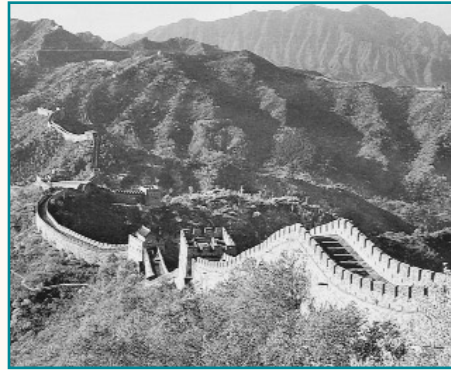
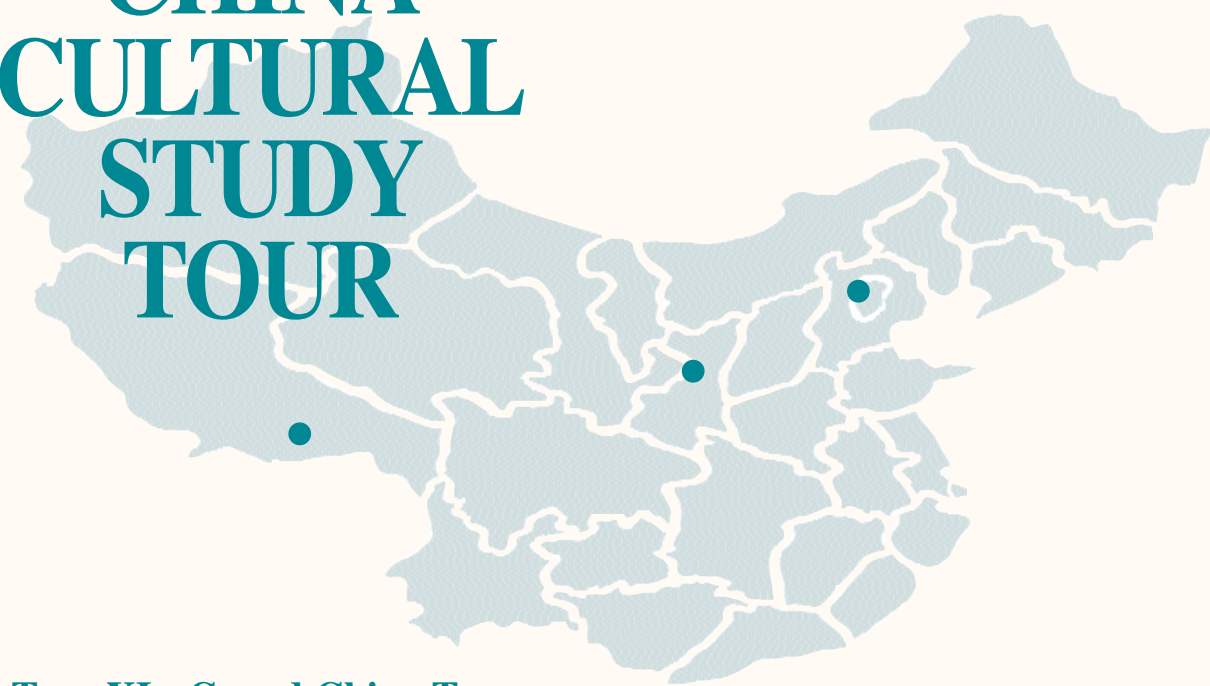




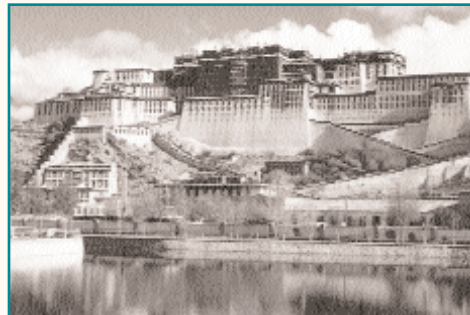

- A day-long excursion to the legendary Great Wall
- After dinner, we will take a non-stop overnight train to Xi'an

## Xi'an

### Day 5

- Arrive Xi'an. Transfer to the Bell Tower Hotel
- Dinner in the hotel
- **B, L, D**

### Day 6

- Visit the Terracotta Warriors
- Circle Vision Movie
- Bronze Chariot, and the renowned Shaanxi Museum
- Tonight, perhaps you want to try out the local dumpling dinner
- **B, L**

## Tibet

### Day 7

- Fly to Lhasa, mountainous capital of Tibet
- Motorcoach to Tsedang (2 hrs)
- The rest of the day is free to adjust to the altitude of the world's highest plateaus-about 12,000 ft above sea level
- Dinner and overnight at the Tsedang Hotel
- **B,D**

### Day 8

- Visit the Yumbulagang, the first palace for the first king in Tibetan history
- Visit the Tomb of Tibetan Kings
- Motorcoach to Lhasa (4 hrs)
- Check in at the Tibet Hotel
- **B,L,D**

### Day 9

- Visit Nobrulingkha (Precious Stone Garden) and the famous Barkhor Market
- Tour Jokhang Temple, one of Tibet's holiest shrines
- **B,L, D**

### Day 10

- Visit the world-famous Potala Palace, former residence of Dalai Lama
- Tour the Drepund Monastery, once home to 10,000 Lamas
- Dinner in the hotel
- **B,L,D**

## Beijing

### Day 11

- Fly back to Beijing
- Check in to the Palace Hotel
- **B**

### Day 12

- Fly home to USA
- **B**

## Tour Fee

**\$3,000** per person based on double occupancy  
(**\$500** extra for single supplement)

The tour fee includes the following:

- Roundtrip airfare from Milwaukee and other approved gateway cities in Wisconsin to China
- All intra-China transportation
- All transfers & portage
- Hotel accommodations
- Meals as indicated
- Admission fees for the tours in the itinerary

## Additional Fees

The tour fee does not include the following:

- All U.S. tax, security and airport taxes (\$116)
- China visa (\$80)
- All intra-China tax, security and airport taxes (\$25)
- Optional gratuities to guides and drivers (\$50-\$60)
- Optional travel insurance (approximately \$134)
